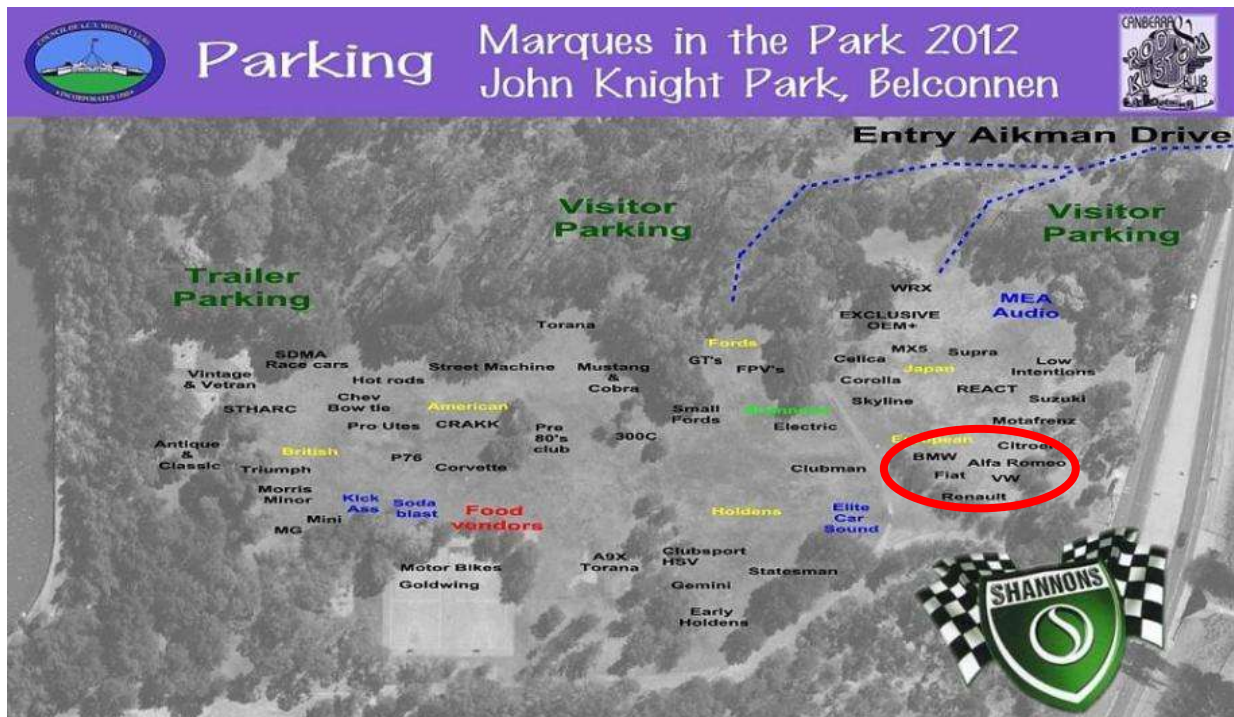
**Marques in the Park Sunday 10 November**

Whoever gets there first can park where told, and others then park either side or near each other within our boundaries. See red circle below for the Italian cars location:

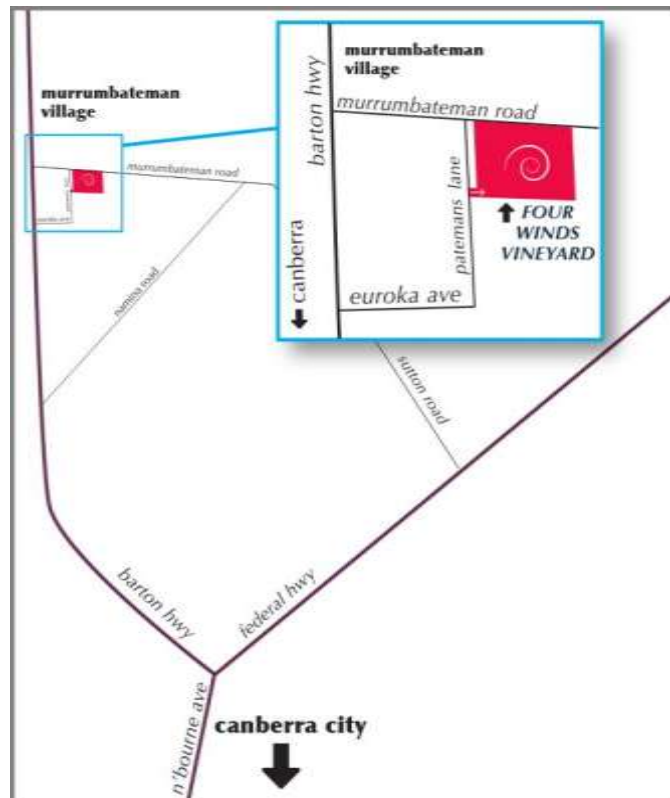




Beware that the Unconcorso is now up for grabs because Matt's very original but somewhat faded 128 is pending rego, and won't be there to defend the title.
